

# Child Health Plan *Plus* (CHP+)

## What is CHP+?

CHP+ is affordable, quality health insurance for Colorado children and pregnant women.

## What are the benefits?

- Well-child check-ups and doctor visits
- Immunizations
- Dental care (for children only)
- Hospital services
- Prescriptions
- Mental/Behavioral health care
- Prenatal care

## CHP+ April 1, 2009 – March 31, 2010 Maximum Income Levels

FAMILY SIZE	MONTHLY INCOME	WEEKLY INCOME	HOURLY WAGE
1	\$1,851	\$430	\$12
2	\$2,490	\$579	\$16
3	\$3,128	\$727	\$20
4	\$3,767	\$876	\$24

Certain expenses such as childcare, medical costs, adult health insurance premiums, child support and alimony payments may be deducted from a family's gross income.

Hence, families may make more money and still qualify for CHP+.

## Who is eligible?

Children ages 18 and under or pregnant woman 19 and over who:

- Are not eligible for Medicaid
- Do not have any other health insurance or have access to State employee health insurance. For example, a parent is a Colorado state employee.
- Live in Colorado and are a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident for at least five years (Refugees, Deportees, Asylees, Cuban or Haitian entrants and victims of trafficking are exceptions to the five-year rule.)
- Parents' citizenship / residency status is not considered when determining CHP+ eligibility for children.

## What does CHP+ cost?

- Families may pay nothing or \$25 to enroll one child or \$35 to enroll two or more children each year.
- Co-payments of \$2 and \$5 for health and dental services may also be required.

## How does a family apply?

- An application must be completed. The application is available in English and Spanish and a family can call 1-800-359-1991 to request one or download an application at [www.CHPplus.org](http://www.CHPplus.org).
